

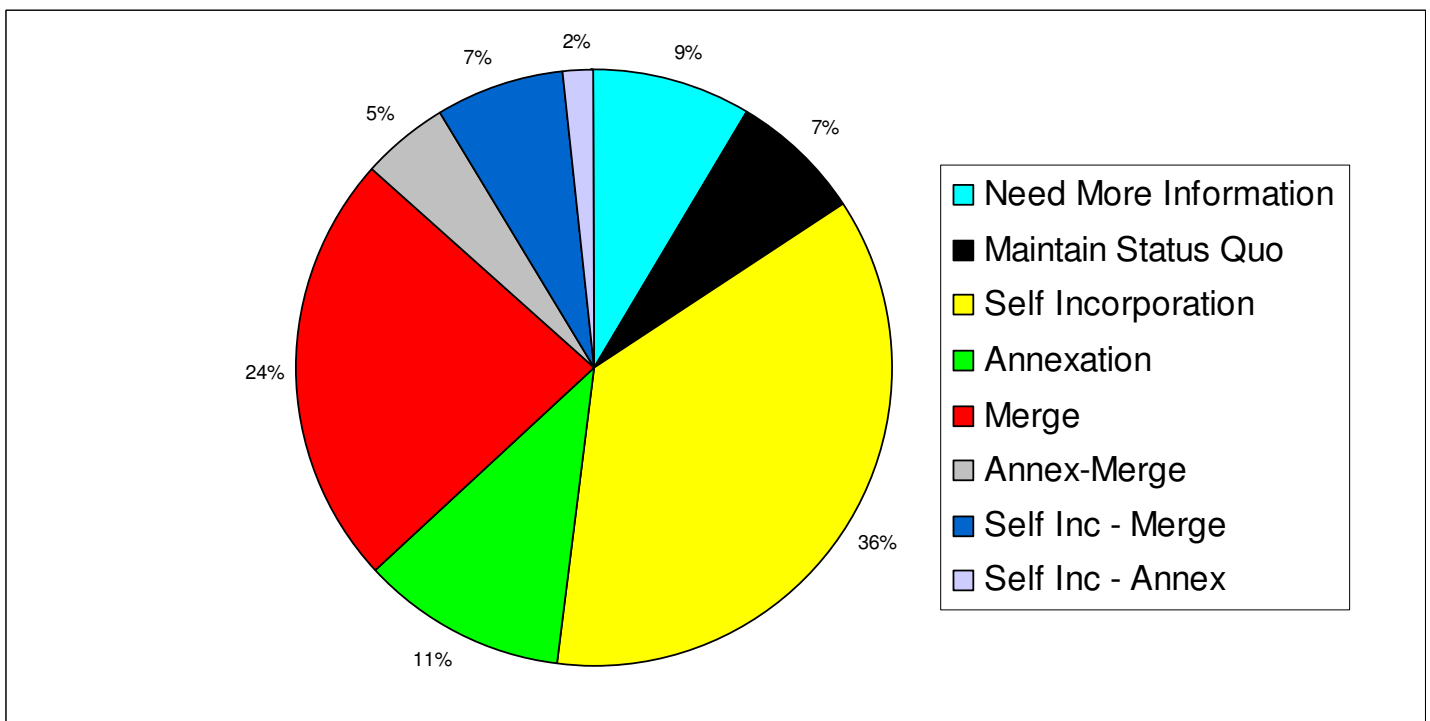
White River Citizens United Meeting Survey – 9-22-2008

The results of the survey conducted at the conclusion of the White River Citizens United meeting on September 22, 2008 are provided below.

- 84% of the respondents favor some form of incorporation and do not reportedly need more information to make a decision. This 84% includes the following breakdown:
36% of the respondents favored self-incorporation. The merge option was the second highest, at 24%. 11% of the respondents indicated a preference for annexation
13% of the respondents indicated multiple preferences – either annex and merge, self-incorporate and merge, or self-incorporate and annex.
- The majority of those favoring merging or annexation prefer an incorporation with Greenwood over Bargersville – 53% vs. 33% - the other 14% indicated no preference.
- 9% of the respondents indicated that more information is needed to make a decision.
- 7% favored maintaining status quo and not incorporating.

Many of the responses that favored self-incorporation or merge / annex with Bargersville stated control as a factor in their consideration.
